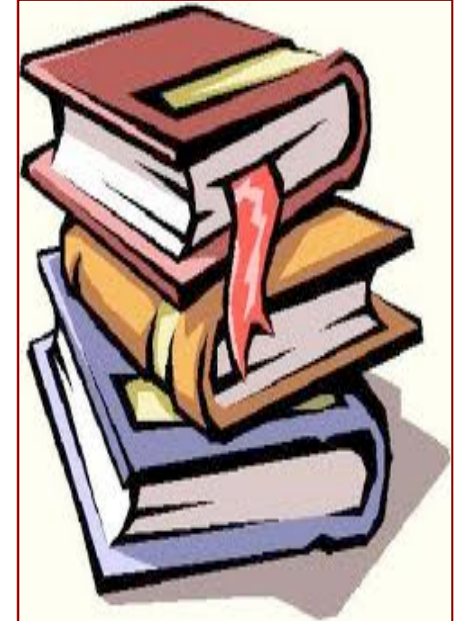

The Goals of the BSRP 180° Peer Tutoring Center is to foster a commitment to young people that will promote pro-social friendships, strong interpersonal skills, and academic success. Only through personal relationships, support, and encouragement can a sense of individual responsibility be established that will give youth the commitment to follow through on a path to adulthood with a sense of pride and accomplishment.

Through repeated struggles in the classroom and the development of destructive habits, many young people today have lost faith in the possibilities that await them if they could successfully put their lives on a positive path. To accomplish this goal, young people must be in a caring, inclusive learning environment that encourages and supports their efforts while reinforcing the character traits of respect and responsibility.

BSRP, in partnership with the 180 Degrees Program, is a direct response to the growing number of young people who are slipping through the cracks in society today.
